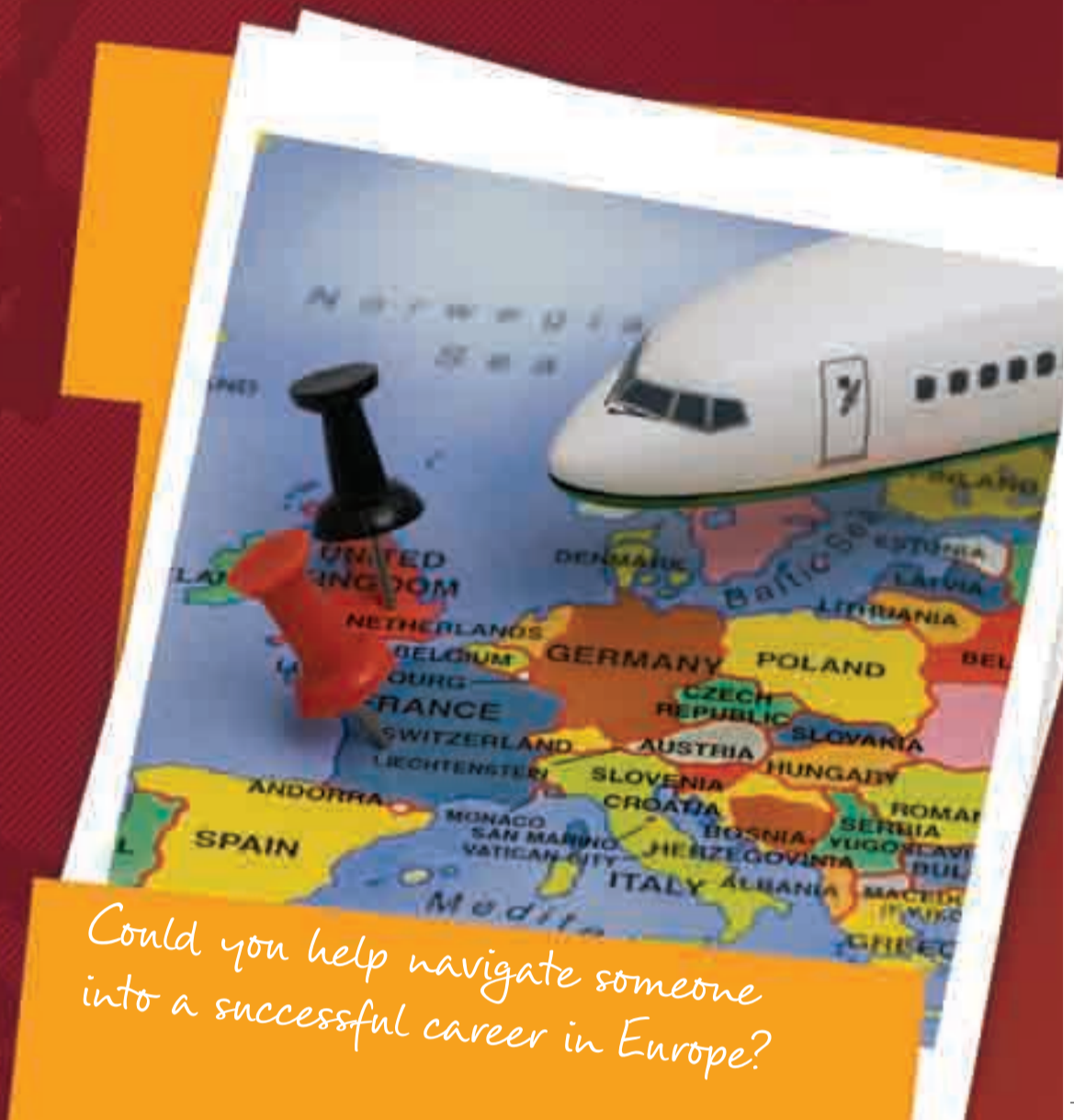

Helping people achieve great things

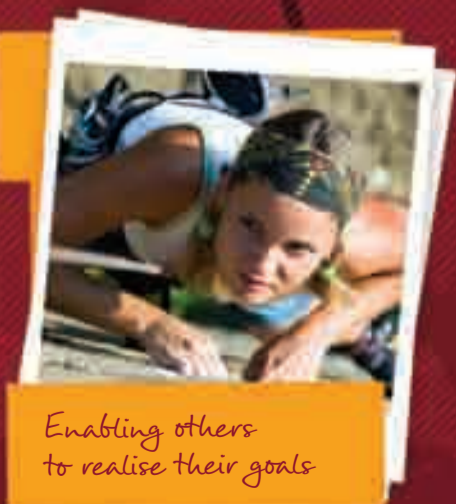
Organisations across Europe work with individuals from a range of different backgrounds to help them achieve their potential, but one of the key difficulties for the individual is being able to record the skills they have learned and back the skills up with evidence. This is where the Europass Mobility Supplement can help.

Europass Mobility can be a useful way to refer to Lifelong Learning Programme activities. It can describe the programme and show the skills gained during the programme activity. It records the linguistic, practical, IT, personal, social, work-based and 'soft' skills that the participant has gained.

This, in turn, helps the individual stand out from the crowd when it comes to applying for work, training or study.

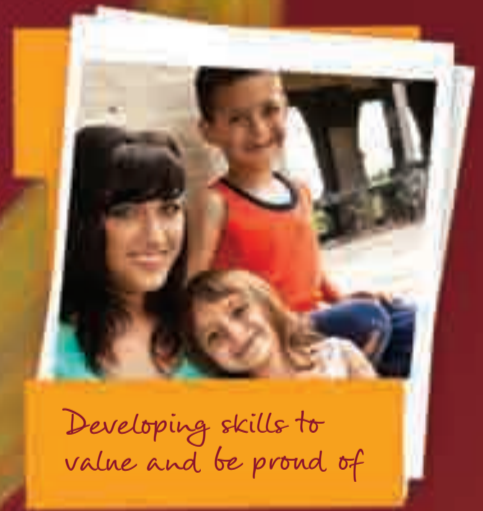

How does it work?

In order for this to work there need to be three participants; the individual, a 'sending' organisation and a 'host' organisation.

Sending Organisations

By registering with Europass Mobility, organisations can help individuals identify the skills and experiences they gain when they are sent on work or study placements within Europe. Under the Europass Mobility scheme organisations can help an individual identify managed activities which will help them develop new skills and competencies. All the organisation has to do is register on the Europass website.

Host Organisations

A host is any organisation offering a short course, voluntary activity or work placement to the individual. Host Organisations should describe the skills and competencies an individual will gain as a result of the experience.
